- 1. Each lab section will be split into three groups of 8 students.
- 2. Members of each group will be given 75 minutes to complete the identification of their three unknowns, clean-up and leave the lab.
 - Group A will start at 8:00 am (Morning sections) or 1:00 pm (Afternoon sections)
 - Group B will start at 9:15 am (Morning sections) or 2:15 pm (Afternoon sections)
 - Group C will start at 10:30 am (Morning sections) or 3:30 pm (Afternoon sections)
- 3. Each student must work alone to determine their unknowns.
 - They may ask questions only of the instructor; the instructor is, however, not obligated to provide answers.
- 4. Each student may make use of the following items during the practicum exam:
 - A computer with Vernier probes.
 - Reagents found in the lab
 - The balances
 - Glassware found in the lab
 - One 4" X 6" note card. The instructor will supply the card. (Yes, you may use both sides and the edges.) These will be collected at the time of the exam.
 - Pencil or pen
 - Calculator
 - Goggles
 - Instructor supplied scratch paper
 - Instructor suppled periodic table
